PROVERBS 4:10-19

MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Run on the bright path of good wisdom you've inherited and do not even think about entering the darkened evil path.

- I.** Run on the Right Path (v.10-13)
- II.** Do Not Enter the Evil Path (v.14-17)
- III.** The Bright & Stable Path vs. the Dark & Stumbling Path (v.18-19)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Whom has God used to give you directions to the right path? Have you thanked them recently?
2. What kind of “stumbling” does this passage refer to? Does v.12 mean you’ll never have trials as a believer?
3. Is v.16-17 an exaggeration? How do they help us understand the doctrine of total depravity?
4. What encouragement does the growth of “brightness” in v.18 give you for your own Christian walk?
5. Where do we see the truth of v.19b in our own society?
