- 2. Our consciences need to be trained. How are you training your conscience? How can you tell if your feeling of guilt is well-based?
- 3. Compare Herod's dealing with horrible sin with David's – what made the difference?
- 4. Boys & girls – when you feel bad for sin, what should you do? How can Jesus help?
