MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Since you have been set free from sin by God for God, flee sexual immorality and pursue purity.

- I. Set Free by God for God (v.12-17)
- II. Flee Sexual Immorality and Pursue Purity (v.18-20)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. In what ways do the problems of the Corinthian church in this passage still affect the church today? What does this say about the timelessness of the Word of God?
2. Does the 7th commandment only speak about sexual sin within a marriage (i.e. adultery)? How does this passage inform your answer? What other passages would you cite?
3. Paul first speaks of gospel realities and then gives gospel commands. Why is this so necessary for understanding and obeying biblical commands?
4. Boys and girls – how can you live a pure life at your age?
