LUKE 11:1-2

MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

When teaching us to pray, our Lord calls us to seek God as our Father and make His chief desires our chief desires.

- I. The Lord Teaches Prayer (v. 1)
- II. The Lord Teaches Us to Seek God as Our Father (v.2a)
- III. The Lord Teaches Us to Make God's Desires Our Desires (v.2b)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Do you struggle in prayer? Why do you think you struggle in this area? What encouragement does this passage give you?
2. What confidence does it give your prayer life when the Son of God teaches you to call His Father your Father?
3. How can these chief desires of God still shape your prayers even if you don't state them outright?
4. Covenant children – do you pray this prayer? You can, looking to the Father in the name of Jesus!
