**MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE**

When teaching us to pray, our Lord calls us to be shamelessly bold in our asking and to be trusting our heavenly Father's good answer.

- II. Be Trusting the Father's Good Answer (v.11-13)

1. Can persistent and shamelessly bold prayer still be reverent? How?
2. Do you struggle with trusting God's goodness in prayer? What does Jesus teach here that corrects your trust?
3. What prayer lesson have you learned the most from Jesus' teaching in verses 1-13?
4. Covenant children – do you trust God's goodness when you pray? Even more than you trust your mom & dad?
